****Notes for programmers:**

Giraffes wander in the space with randomized routes. Each of them has six slots in their array. Giraffe 0 starts with a full sentence. Giraffe 1-13 only sing one preassigned measure when the performance begins.

When two giraffes collide, they adopt each others' parts until the array reaches a maximum of six measures, after which they replace the earliest one in the list with the new one when they adopt a new measure.

Goldfish sing every 3-7 seconds and the time between each repetition is randomized. Eggs and Crabs loop their measures.
